**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: www.pre-cana.org for dates and registration.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Communion to the Homebound: Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center.** At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. Baptisms are celebrated in **English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica.** **Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Those who speak **Spanish** and wish to have a Spanish language ceremony, will have **their registration and instruction session on the First Saturday of each month after the 7:30 pm Mass in the Basilica. Spanish Baptisms are celebrated at the Spanish Mass on Saturdays at 7:30 pm in the Basilica.**

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a Baptism celebration.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

From the Pastor's Desk....



We are still joyful! The day of Easter has passed, but the effects of Easter are only just beginning. Did you notice all the people who came to our Holy Week services this year? Did you see how many more Chinese and Spanish speaking immigrants chose to join us as a parish for these celebrations? Did you notice how beautiful the Church looked? Did you hear the joy in the music which was sung by the choir and by us?

Did you see the smiles on the faces of our people when they were leaving Church? These are the signs which the Holy Spirit gives to us to let us know that He is with us as we pray.

Perhaps you didn't notice these things. Perhaps you were so occupied with your own thoughts and worries that you didn't even allow the Holy Spirit to touch your heart or open your eyes. Most people call it "distraction". I call it "obstruction". In one of the Gospels Jesus says: "...behold, I stand at the door and knock". The door could be the one which could let Him into our hearts, but it still has the big stone in front of it which needs to be rolled away. When we roll away the stones of our own sins, our spiritual laziness, our own excuses for not growing in our faith; we will certainly find the power of the Risen Lord inside our hearts waiting to be discovered. This is the Easter power which can change anything and anyone. We have to believe in it and trust Him. When we hold back on this power, we are the ones who lose.

During this Eastertime, it is our prayer for each family to ask the Risen Lord to help them experience His saving power in their lives. "Ask, and you shall receive."

Como el apóstol Tomás, cuando profesó abiertamente su fe en Jesús: ¡Señor mío y Dios mío!. Nuestro Señor, vuelto a la vida después del Viernes Santo, se aparece en el Cenáculo a sus discípulos, con los signos evidentes de la crucifixión en sus manos y en sus pies. Jesús resucitado muestra a Tomás su costado abierto por la lanza del soldado, invitándolo a meter su mano en el pecho traspasado. Y, como Tomás, exigimos también nosotros demasiadas pruebas para creer. Pero la fe es, por definición, creer lo que no vemos y dar el libre consentimiento de nuestra mente, de nuestro corazón y de nuestra voluntad, a la palabra de Dios. La fe es un don de Dios que transforma totalmente la existencia y la visión de las cosas.

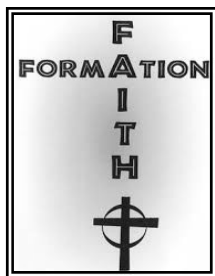
