**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: www.pre-cana.org for dates and registration.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Communion to the Homebound: Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. Baptisms are celebrated in **English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica**. **Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Those who speak **Spanish** and wish to have a Spanish language ceremony, will have their registration and instruction session on the **First Saturday of each month after the 7:30 pm Mass in the Basilica**. **Spanish Baptisms are celebrated at the Spanish Mass on Saturdays at 7:30 pm in the Basilica.**

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a **Baptism celebration**.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

La Conversión de San Pablo: sucedió que yendo de camino, cuando estaba cerca de Damasco, de repente le rodeó una luz venida del cielo; cayó a tierra y oyó una voz que le decía: Saulo, Saulo, ¿Por qué me persigues?. El respondió: ¿Quién eres tú Señor? Y oyó que le decían: Yo soy Jesús a quien tú persigues. Pero ahora levántate; entra en la ciudad, y allí se te dirá lo que tendrás que hacer. Los hombres que iban con él se habían detenido mudos de espanto, pero no veían a nadie. Saulo se levantó del suelo, y aunque tenía los ojos abiertos no veía nada. Lo llevaron de la mano y lo hicieron entrar en Damasco. Pasó tres días sin comer y sin beber. Había en Damasco un discípulo llamado Ananías. El Señor le dijo en una visión: ¡Ananías! El respondió: "Aquí estoy Señor" y el Señor le dijo: "Levántate, vete a la calle Recta y pregunta en la casa de Judas por uno de Tarso que se llama Saulo; mira: él está en oración y está viendo que un hombre llamado Ananías entra y le coloca las manos sobre la cabeza y le devuelve la vista. Respondió Ananías y dijo: Señor, he oído a muchos hablar de ese hombre y de los males que ha causado a tus seguidores en Jerusalén, y que ha venido aquí con poderes de los Sumos Sacerdotes para llevar presos a todos los que creen en tu nombre, el Señor le respondió: vete, pues a éste lo he elegido como un instrumento para que lleve mi nombre ante los que no conocen la verdadera religion, ante los gobernantes y ante los hijos de Israel. Fue Ananías. Entró en la casa. Le colocó sus manos sobre la cabeza y le dijo: hermano Saulo, me ha enviado a ti el Señor Jesús, el que se te apareció en el camino por donde venías, me ha enviado para que recobres la vista y seas lleno del Espíritu Santo, al instante se le cayeron de los ojos como unas escamas y recobró la vista, se levantó y fue bautizado y enseguida se puso a predicar en favor de Jesús, en las sinagogas o casas de oración, y decía que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios. Todos los que lo escuchaban quedaban admirados y decían: ¿No es éste el que en Jerusalén perseguía tan violentamente a los que invocaban el nombre de Jesús? Pero Saulo seguía predicando y demostraba a muchos que Jesús es el Mesías, el salvador del mundo. Saulo se cambió el nombre por el de Pablo.

Make me more deeply aware of my heritage; realizing not only my rights but also my duties and responsibilities as a citizen.

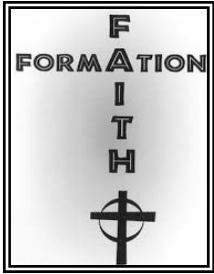
Make this great land and all its people know clearly Your will, that they may fulfill the destiny ordained for us in the salvation of the nations, and the restoring of all things in Christ.

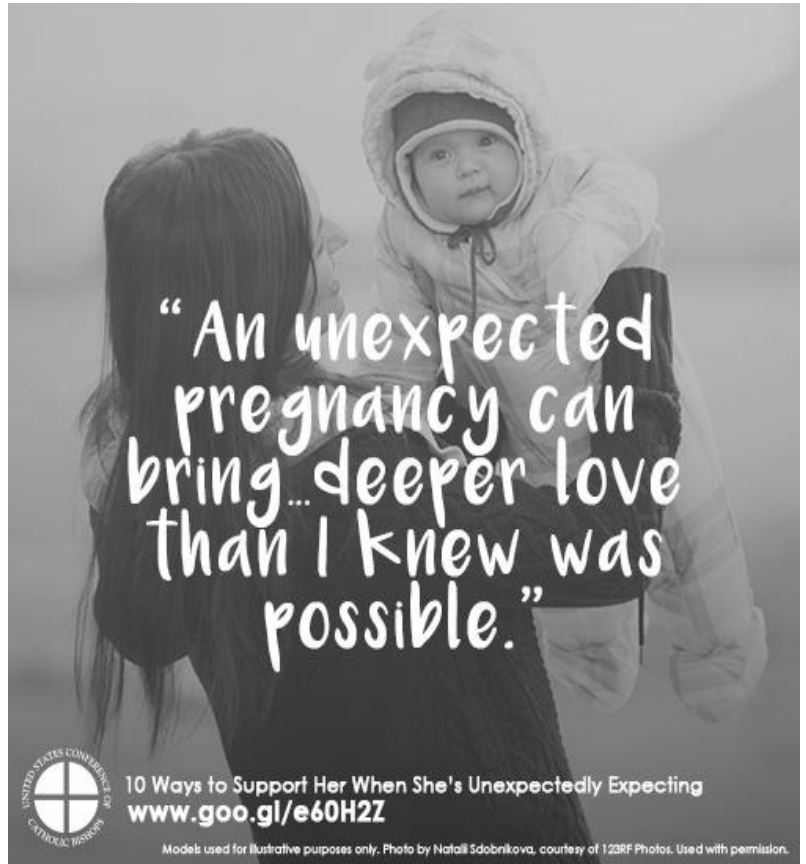
