**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: www.pre-cana.org for dates and registration.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Communion to the Homebound: Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. Baptisms are celebrated in **English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica**. **Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Those who speak **Spanish** and wish to have a Spanish language ceremony, will have **their registration and instruction session on the First Saturday of each month after the 7:30 pm Mass in the Basilica**. **Spanish Baptisms are celebrated at the Spanish Mass on Saturdays at 7:30 pm in the Basilica.**

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a Baptism celebration.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

DECREE

I, the undersigned Bishop of Brooklyn, decree that the **Church of Saint Rosalia**, located at 6301 14th Avenue in the Borough of Brooklyn, which is within the territory of the **Parish of the Basilica of Regina Pacis** is hereby **RELEGATED TO THE PROFANE BUT NOT SORDID USE** according to the provisions of Can. 1222 §2.

After a careful consideration of the pastoral and financial needs, a determination was reached that the cost of maintaining Saint Rosalia as an additional worship site was prohibitive to both the **Parish of the Basilica of Regina Pacis** as well as to the **Diocese of Brooklyn**, especially in light of the significant financial hardship being experienced by both entities.

Taking into consideration the needs of the entire **Diocese of Brooklyn**, especially in light of the shortage of priests available for ministry as well as the significant financial burden that this structure is imposing on the **Parish of the Basilica of Regina Pacis** and in view of the current demographical shifts that have resulted in a diminished number of faithful in the surrounding area, I have decided to permanently relegate this space to the profane but not sordid use.

Reverend Monsignor Ronald T. Marino, Pastor, wrote to request that the Church of Saint Rosalia be relegated from the sacred to profane. Prior to the issuance of this decree and in keeping with the universal norms of the Roman Catholic Church, after consultation with parishioners as well as the Episcopal Vicar for Brooklyn, the **Reverend Monsignor Joseph Grimaldi**, and after having definitely determined that the care of souls would not suffer because of this decision due to the close proximity of the parish church, I consented to this reduction.


After having determined that *no other parties can legitimately claim rights for themselves* in the **Church of Saint Rosalia**, I presented this matter for *consultation* to the **Diocesan Presbyteral Council on Tuesday, February 14, 2017**. Having considered the matter carefully, the Council overwhelmingly supported my decision to relegate this structure.

Therefore, having carefully followed the provision set forth in Can. 1222 §2 and having determined with moral certitude that the care of souls would suffer no detriment, I declare that this decree will take effect thirty days (30) after its publication and that by virtue of the same the **Church of Saint Rosalia** will no longer be used for divine worship. In addition, I order that any

sacred furnishing and artwork, which the **Parish of the Basilica of Regina Pacis** does not retain for its own use, be disposed of in a manner befitting their character and the known intentions of any donor. Furthermore, in addition to the usual requirements of law for the *valid and licit* alienation by the parish of the property concerned, the sale of the church is subject to my approval as being consonant with the requirements of Can. 1222 §2.

En Sintonía.**La Ascensión del Señor**

La Ascensión es sin duda un misterio de la vida de Cristo poco meditado. Sin embargo, adquiere especial importancia porque es parte de la Resurrección de Cristo. No se entendería la Resurrección sin la Ascensión. De entre las muchas enseñanzas de la Ascensión podríamos considerar estas dos: Cristo fue levantado de la tierra para atraer a todos hacia Él y para sentarse a la derecha del Padre, como profesamos en la oración del credo cada domingo. La elevación de Cristo en la cruz significa y anuncia la elevación en la Ascensión al cielo, por ello encontramos en la cruz el inicio de su ascensión. Y todo con este único fin, atraer a todos los hombres hacia Él. Jesús aceptó subir a la cruz para mantenernos unidos a Él, para que ninguno se perdiera. Algo parece evidente: los discípulos no se alegran de que se marche el Maestro. Cristo, esta en su glorificación, en su majestuoso regreso al Padre. Los apóstoles, hombres con un poderoso sentido común, alcanzaban a comprender que, si Jesús había venido al mundo por ellos (y por todos los hombres), había muerto por ellos, por ellos había resucitado. Cuando realmente se comprende y se cree en el cielo, cambia el sentido de la muerte. Ésta ya no aparece como el esqueleto armado que nos priva de tantas alegrías, de nuestras amistades, de esta vida tan hermosa. Se transforma en el amable portero que nos abre la casa del Padre, la casa de los hermanos que nos han precedido, nuestra casa. Y cada nuevo cumpleaños, se convierte en un trecho que nos acerca más a nuestra meta, a nuestro verdadero destino. Pero la alegría de los apóstoles no se alimentaba sólo de esperanza. Habían comprendido también que, a la luz de ese cielo, se esclarecía el horizonte de esta breve vida haced discípulos míos, enseñándoles a guardar todo lo que yo os he mandado. Se transformaba en un nuevo cielo pues no es verdad solamente que Dios esté en el cielo. No lo es menos que donde se halla él, el cielo le acompaña.

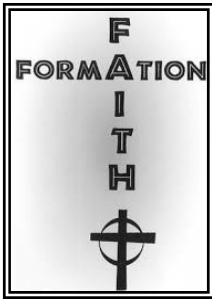
