**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: www.pre-cana.org for dates and registration.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Communion to the Homebound: Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. Baptisms are celebrated in **English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica**. **Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Those who speak **Spanish** and wish to have a Spanish language ceremony, will have their registration and instruction session on the **First Saturday of each month after the 7:30 pm Mass in the Basilica**. **Spanish Baptisms are celebrated at the Spanish Mass on Saturdays at 7:30 pm in the Basilica.**

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a **Baptism celebration**.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

Mass is very important.**

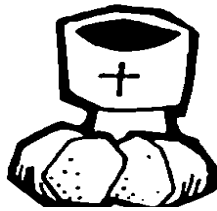
When our Faith Formation Students go to any Mass at Regina Pacis on a Saturday evening or on Sunday, they should place their attendance card with the correct date, **along with their written names**, in the collection basket. If they attend Mass in another Church on any Sunday, they should ask that Priest to sign the back of the card which has that Sunday's date. It can be handed in the next time they attend Mass at Regina Pacis.

If your child does not go to any Mass on a given weekend you may dispose of the dated card for that weekend. We will keep track of these cards all summer long and in September assess how many Masses the children missed during the summer.

Sunday even when they are on vacation.

The Holy Father speaks...

"Do this'. Jesus on a previous occasion asked His disciples to 'do' what was so clear to Him, in obedience to the will of the Father. In the Gospel, Jesus says to the disciples in front of the tired and hungry crowds: 'Give them something to eat yourselves'. Indeed, it is Jesus Who blesses and breaks the loaves and provides sufficient food to satisfy the whole crowd, but it is the disciples who offer the five loaves and two fish. Jesus wanted it this way: that, instead of sending the crowd away, the disciples would put at His disposal what little they had. And there is another gesture: the pieces of bread, broken by the holy and venerable hands of Our Lord, pass into the poor hands of the disciples, who distribute these to the people. This too is the disciples 'doing' with Jesus; with Him they are able to 'give them something to eat'. Clearly this miracle was not intended merely to



satisfy hunger for a day, but rather it signals what Christ wants to accomplish for the salvation of all mankind, giving His own flesh and blood. And yet this needs always to happen through those two small actions: offering the few loaves and fish which we have; receiving the bread broken by the hands of Jesus and giving it to all."

En Sintonía.**Solemnidad del Corpus Christi.***El Cuerpo de Cristo nos Salva-nos Perdona-nos Une.*

Corpus Christi es la presencia de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. En este día recordamos solemnemente la institución de la Eucaristía que se llevó a cabo el **Jueves Santo** durante la Última Cena, al convertir Jesús el pan y el vino en su Cuerpo y en su Sangre. Nosotros contemplamos esta presencia de Jesús hecho pan en El SAGRARIO, es el lugar donde se “**reserva**” la Eucaristía. Esta conversión

del pan y del vino en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús se produce por la Sucesión Apostólica, el Papa, Obispos y Sacerdotes tienen el poder de consagrar el pan y el vino, y Jesús actuando en ellos transforma esas especies en su Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad en su estado actual, es decir, Resucitado, dador de Vida en Abundancia y de Poder en el Espíritu, esta transformación se la llama “**transubstanciación**” Cambia la substancia del pan, que no es ya más pan, sino el Cuerpo Resucitado de Jesús, y lo mismo con el vino. Permanecen lo que filosóficamente se llaman los accidentes: el color del pan, su gusto, su aroma al tacto, su sonido cuando lo partimos. Pero no su substancia, que es ya el Cuerpo del Señor. ¿Qué formas de adoración existen fuera de la Misa, que es el lugar de consagración del pan y del vino en el Cuerpo y en la Sangre de Jesús? La exposición con el Copón, abriendo el tabernáculo o bien exponiéndolo sobre el altar. La exposición con la Custodia (ostensorio en forma circular de Sol, cuyos rayos rectos representan la luz y el calor, y sus rayos ondulados la virtud del amor de Dios). Colocada sobre el altar nos alimenta uniéndonos a él.

En el Día del Padre, tenemos la obligación de felicitarle y transmitirle nuestro agradecimiento. Para los padres y abuelos que nos han dado apoyo, Muchas gracias!!!

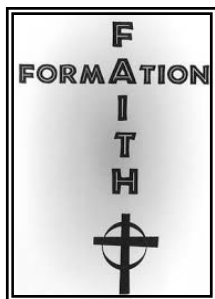

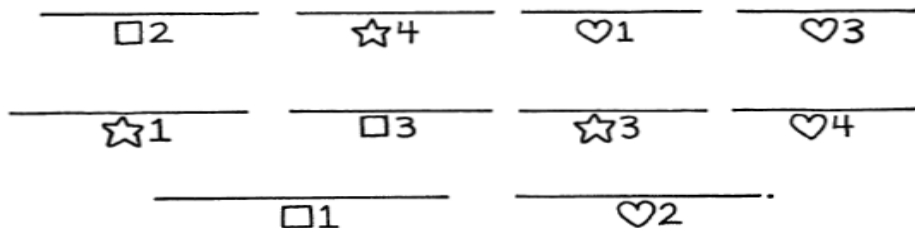
