**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS  
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

**Confessions:** Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

**Marriage:** Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: [www.pre-cana.org](http://www.pre-cana.org) for dates and registration.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

**Communion to the Homebound:** Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

**Baptism:** Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. Baptisms are celebrated in **English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica**. **Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Those who speak **Spanish** and wish to have a Spanish language ceremony, will have their registration and instruction session on the **First Saturday of each month after the 7:30 pm Mass in the Basilica**. **Spanish Baptisms are celebrated at the Spanish Mass on Saturdays at 7:30 pm in the Basilica.**

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a **Baptism celebration**.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

## ***From the Pastor's Desk....***

The Basilica of Regina Pacis is the most Sacred place in our neighborhood. It is the "House of God." As such, it deserves the most respect possible.

On our part, we try to keep it as clean and shiny as possible, no matter the weather. Yet we now need to encourage people to think about "God's house" when they come here. It is not proper to bring coffee, soda, snacks, other food items, etc. into the Church. There still remains in effect a one hour fast from food or drink before receiving Holy Communion. Only the sick are excused from this.

Children must be taught respect, and how to behave in Church. The youngest and the noisiest ones should be brought into the sound proof "Little Catholics Chapel" on the right side of the front of the Church. Older kids need to be quiet and sit still without having to feed them to be quiet! Electronic toys and games are not the way to teach children about what is happening in Church.

Every Sunday after the Masses we have to clean up candy wrappers, coffee cups, napkins, chewing gum, etc. from the pews. You would think it is a movie theater!

**PLEASE** help us to stay respectful of our beautiful Basilica. Please treat it like you believe that the Lord lives there, because He does!

Hay una unicidad que caracteriza a los Doce llamados por el Señor, pero al mismo tiempo existe una continuidad en la misión apostólica, la finalidad de esta misión es una humanidad transformada en una glorificación viva de Dios, el culto verdadero que Dios espera: este es el sentido más profundo de la catolicidad, una catolicidad que ya nos ha sido donada y hacia la cual, sin embargo, debemos avanzar siempre de nuevo. Catolicidad no sólo expresa una reunión de muchas personas en la unidad; también nos enseña a dirigir nuestra mirada a Dios, sólo abriéndonos a él, podemos llegar a ser realmente uno.

*The Holy Father speaks...*



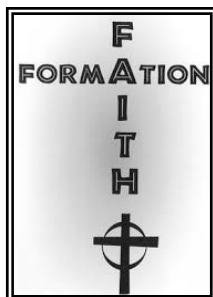

## **REMINDER: Attendance at Mass is very important.**

When our Faith Formation Students go to any  
Mass at Regina Pacis on a Saturday evening or  
on Sunday, they should place their attendance  
card with the correct date, **along with their  
written names**, in the collection basket. If they  
attend Mass in another Church on any Sunday,  
they should ask that Priest to sign the back of  
the card which has that Sunday's date. It can  
be handed in the next time they attend Mass at  
Regina Pacis.

If your child does not go to any Mass on a given  
weekend you may dispose of the dated card for  
that weekend. We will keep track of these  
cards all summer long and in September assess  
how many Masses the children missed during  
the summer.
