**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

Confessions: Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

Marriage: Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: www.pre-cana.org for dates and registration.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

Communion to the Homebound: Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

Baptism: Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. **Baptisms are celebrated in English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica. Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

Baptisms are celebrated in Spanish on the second Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica. Spanish "Registration and Instructions" on the first Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. in the Basilica Conference Center.

It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a Baptism celebration.

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

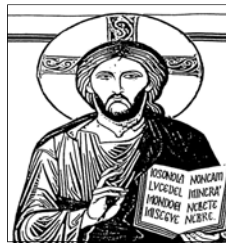

**If I am attracted to
the priesthood and
priestly life, does

Possibly, but not necessarily. A man must pray a
great deal, listening with both heart and soul to
know what God wants him to do. If you feel
some attraction at this point, just continue to
pray, go to Mass, and live a Christian life. If you
are living a Christian life, Jesus will let you know
when the time comes. Also, go talk with your
parish priest or with the vocation director. Try to
come to diocesan-sponsored retreats and
discernment nights. The vocation director can
help you determine if in fact God is calling you to
the priesthood.

From the Pastor's Desk.....

December 8th will mark the **Fifth Anniversary of the designation of Regina Pacis Church as a Papal Basilica.**

I think we can all remember the excitement and joy we felt during all the festivities and celebrations we had on "Basilica Weekend" in 2012. People were so proud of be members of this parish and were inviting friends and relatives to come here for a visit to the new Basilica. Ordinary parishioners were to be found explaining the "Papal Umbrella" in the sanctuary, and the "Tintinabulum" bell which stands next to it. (*Do you remember what they stand for?*)

Since 2012, many articles have been written about the Basilica of Regina Pacis. Television programs and interviews were filmed inside our beautiful basilica, and people still marvel with eyes wide open when they enter in.

In these past five years the Holy Spirit has been very active in our parish. We have welcomed hundreds of new parishioners including those who speak Spanish and Chinese. We have baptized 515 babies, celebrated 610 funerals, 228 weddings and 443 first Communions. The families at all of these special events all entered our open doors to receive the graces and strength they needed from the Holy Spirit.

Of course, since 2012, we have built the beautiful "Chapel of St. Joseph" which people love and marvel at, and which has already included a peaceful resting place for the remains of 31 individuals thus far, with over 100 more niches purchased for the future needs of families. Because we are a Basilica, we can assure everyone that we will remain open and active in perpetuity. What a privilege it is to be buried inside a Basilica where people pray, have Mass, sing and meditate weekly. (That's why I will be buried in the Chapel when my time comes.)

When I reflect on the good work of our priests and staff these past years, and can see, with my own eyes, the actual growth of our Parish taking place, I become more and more convinced that Our Lady is watching over us and protecting this holy place.

I always say that our Basilica is the "... *most sacred building in our neighborhood*". There is life here, there is love here, and there is peace here.

May God continue to bless us on our anniversary.
