**SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS  
AND OTHER INFORMATION**

**Confessions:** Every weekday morning after Mass in the Basilica you may ask the Priest for confession. Saturdays from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Basilica.

**Marriage:** Couples must arrange their wedding ceremony at least 6 months beforehand. Every couple must attend a Pre-Cana meeting. Log on to: [www.pre-cana.org](http://www.pre-cana.org) for dates and registration.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** If you know you are going to be hospitalized, consider receiving the Sacrament of Anointing beforehand at any weekday Mass. Ask the priest before Mass in the sacristy.

**Communion to the Homebound:** Our Eucharistic Ministers are happy to bring Holy Communion to the homebound. To arrange this, please call the Rectory.

**Baptism:** Parents wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism with their children must attend a "Registration and Instruction Session" on the **First Saturday of any month at 11 am in the Basilica Conference Center**. At these sessions it will be necessary for both parents to attend, and to bring a copy of the baby's birth certificate. Necessary registration forms will be completed, the required instruction will take place, and the Baptism will be scheduled. Remember, both Godparents must be Catholic, 16 years old, and must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Godparents may attend these sessions but are not required to do so. **Baptisms are celebrated in English on the third Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica. Once this session is completed, you may schedule the ceremony for any month.**

**Baptisms are celebrated in Spanish on the second Saturday of each month at noon in the Basilica. Spanish "Registration and Instructions" are on the first Friday evening at 7:30 p.m. in the Basilica Conference Center.**

**It is no longer necessary to come to the Rectory Office to set up a Baptism celebration.**

You may call the rectory for *Chinese* or *Italian* Baptisms.

## ***From the Pastor's Desk.....***

Once again, we find ourselves welcoming and saying good luck to our parish priests.

First of all, we welcome **Fr. Nelson Cipollone** to our Parish to serve as Parochial Vicar. Father Nelson was born in Argentina in 1969 and grew up there before he moved to Italy. He studied at schools in Cordoba, Argentina. In 1999 he moved to Rome to complete his theological studies at the Lateran University. He is now officially a priest of the Archdiocese of Pescara in Abruzzo on loan to us. Father Nelson speaks Spanish and Italian fluently and is working hard on his English. We welcome him and pray for his ministry with us.

We must also bid farewell to **Fr. Francis S. Rosario**, whom the Bishop has asked to minister to immigrants from Bangladesh who now live principally in Queens. Fr. Francis is Indian, but fluent in the Bengali language. We thank him for his service here this past summer and offer him our prayers for a successful ministry in his new assignment.

### **Let's help the Holy Spirit...**

Bishop DiMarzio has asked the whole Diocese to make this year of 2017-2018 a special "Year for Vocations". As such, we are planning some activities to support this request.

We have dedicated space in our weekly bulletin to help understand what a vocation is all about, and how it is part of every person. We pray every Thursday morning for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. All the parishes of our Deanery will invite young men to come to Regina on **Sunday, October 15 at 4 pm** to meet with and speak to *Bishop Neil Tiedemann* about this in a general way. This is called "**Project Andrew**". Then on **October 29** we will have a **communion brunch** in the gymnasium for all families. Here, *Bishop Octavio Cisneros* will be a guest speaker while parents and kids will enjoy pancakes, etc.

A vocation is a call from the Holy Spirit to guide you to respond to what God wants from you in your life. It is not only about priests and religious, but also the vocation of the married and single life. The theme of this brunch is "*How to listen to God's call*". Tickets are available in the Rectorry or after each Sunday Mass in the lobby of the Basilica. Please join us in these activities as a means of offering your support to these important efforts.
